- While my associates were working on some other project, I followed up with my previous missions, extended the network via the EPFL, helped move the legacy virtualization infrastructure to an EPYC cluster and started deploying VXLAN devices, aside from Juniper MX240 as backbone routers. Our BGP ring is now fully redundant, validates RPKI, with multiple well connected transits. I was also the first contact for most of our team of 15 employees.

- I'm updating the standards of the network that is running between more than five PoPs in town, and I'm improving the resiliency of the network to be able to handle customer increase. I designed, planned and managed the migration process needed to move from a multiple single point of failure design to a failover design. I also planned and streamlined the upgrade path for the server infrastructure with my colleagues. As a senior, I was also the decision maker for any issues that may occur without the company owners.

As such I am responsible for optimizing latency, routing, and financial costs for IP-Max as well as for our customers. I supported ProtonMail in mitigating a large DDoS attack on their infrastructure, and upgraded their network design for improved redundancy and resilience.
